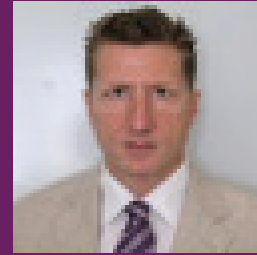

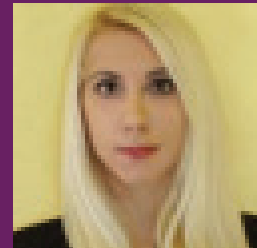
Edoardo Riva
